The Clintonville Public Library chooses to use social media (such as, but not limited to: blogs, website, social networking sites, email, etc.) to engage library customers in discussions of books, materials, and programs. Posted comments are the opinion of the author only and publication of a comment does not imply endorsement or agreement by the Clintonville Public Library. Your submission of a comment constitutes your acceptance of this policy. If you do not comply, your message will be removed from public viewing:

1. We do not allow graphic, obscene, explicit, or racial comments or submissions, nor do we allow comments that are abusive, hateful, or intended to defame anyone or any organization.
2. We do not allow comments that suggest or encourage illegal activity.
3. You participate at your own risk, taking personal responsibility for your comments, your username, and any information provided.
4. We do not allow solicitations or advertisements. This includes promotion or endorsement of any financial, commercial, or non-governmental agency. Similarly, we do not allow attempts to defame or defraud any financial, commercial or non-governmental agency.
5. Appearance of external links does not constitute official endorsement on behalf of Clintonville Public Library nor do they represent our views.
6. Clintonville Public Library has sole authority to remove posts that are deemed inappropriate.
